ARRIVAL & DISMISSAL

Thank you for your help in making arrival and dismissal go more smoothly each day. Please keep in mind that when it rains, you will need a bit more patience when dropping children at school. For safety reasons, please continue to only drop your children off in the car rider loop. **Reminder: Doors open at 8:45. Please do not drop children off or let them walk to arrive earlier.**

BUS LOOP

Cars are NOT permitted in the bus loop while there are buses there!!

CAR RIDER LOOP

For speed and safety, make sure your child has a note so s/he may be dismissed with car riders. All car riders are dismissed through the side door near kindergarten.

Here are a few reminders for safety in the car loop:

- 1) Remain in your car and have your child enter and exit through the passenger door.
- 2) Students may not be dropped off in either parking lot. If you go to the parking lot, park and escort your child to the school.
- 3) Cars may not be left running on school property (this is a law!).
- 4) If your child is not ready to exit in the car loop, please be courteous and pull to the parking lot until s/he is ready.



WALKERS

Students who walk home from school may only exit through the back door to the blacktop. If you are meeting your child, please do not ask your child to meet you anywhere but in the car loop or on the blacktop. Students may not go to the parking lot without an adult accompanying them. If you would prefer adult supervision for your children until you meet them, send a note to have them wait in the car rider loop.



WE LOVE DOGS, BUT NOT AT SCHOOL

Did you know that coaches that use our property for practice and games must spend time cleaning up after dogs before they let children on the field?

Please remember, no dogs are allowed on school property at any time. This is according to Anne Arundel County Code of Law and is a safety and health issue. Walking dogs on school property is not allowed. Please do not bring dogs with you when you are walking to or picking up children from school. We have had a number of complaints because of dog waste as well as children who have allergies or are afraid of dogs. Thank you for your assistance.


FEDERAL IMPACT AID

SURVEY FORMS

On Friday, September 30, your child will bring home a Federal Impact Aid Survey Form. Please assist us by filling out the information requested on the form and return it with your child to Shipley's Choice Elementary School. The U.S. Department of Education has now requested a separate survey form for **each child, the complete address of the Parent/Guardian's Employer if they work on Federal Property, the complete address of the Federal Property on which they work, and each survey must be signed and dated by the Parent/Guardian.** If needed, additional forms may be obtained from the school or downloaded from the AACPS website (www.aacps.org) under **Students, Forms**. The Federal Impact Aid Survey Form for 2016-2017 will be available to download on September 30, 2016. We will also be using our Connect-Ed Automated Telephone Notification System to remind everyone about the significance of completing and returning this survey. The school system receives approximately \$2 million in funding from the Federal government in support of our children after the forms are processed.

In an effort to communicate more clearly with parents, the Art Department is requiring that Art Teachers include an assessment rubric for student art projects. There are so many advantages to the program: It's an online portfolio of your child's work for the time they attend SCES. It can be seen by friends and family around the world. It's free. It's safe and private. Your child can get ideas for art projects that they might like to do at home. You can purchase items with your child's art imprinted on it. Some of the proceeds of the sale go back to the school.

Previously I was able to enter your email into the site. The new policy is that parents must enter their own email and give permission for their child to participate. PLEASE stop by the Art Room on Back to School Night to register if you do not have an Artsonia account. It will take 1 minute! Honest! This applies to all Kindergarten parents, families who are new to the school, and those who did not register previously.

AVOID


